¹ **unemployed persons** – jobless people, ready to work and actively seeking employment. The definition includes persons registered as unemployed in accordance with national regulations, even if they do not meet all three criteria. The unemployed are both the unemployed as defined in the survey of the economic activity of the population and the persons registered as unemployed. The definition does not include full-time students, even if they meet the above criteria. Persons eligible for maternity or parental leave who are unemployed within the meaning of this definition (do not receive holiday benefits) are also unemployed¹ as defined in the Guidelines;

² **professionally inactive** – people who do not currently create labor resources (i.e. they are not working² and are not unemployed). Full-time students are considered to be professionally inactive. Persons on parental leave (understood as absence from work, caused by caring for a child during a period that does not fall under maternity or parental leave) are considered to be professionally inactive, unless they are already registered as unemployed (then the status of the unemployed has priority²) Self-employed persons (including a family member assisting for free the self-employed person) are not considered economically inactive;
